Checking for Understanding Think-Pair-Share

Think-Pair-Share is an effective engagement strategy used at Drouin South Primary School to enhance student understanding. This structured discussion method encourages students to think individually about a topic, pair up to discuss their thoughts with a



partner, and then share their ideas with the larger group. It promotes active participation, ensures all students are involved, and helps check for understanding in a collaborative environment. By breaking down the discussion into manageable steps, Think-Pair-Share fosters deeper comprehension and allows teachers to assess and address any misconceptions in real-time.

Time: 5.00 pm -6.30 pm


